

METHOD STATEMENT

Outline handlay

Last revised 7th April 2010

To lay bitumen coated/non-bitumen coated material as required by the contract

Binder course/surface course

Material will be tipped on the ground as close to the work area as possible. Every effort to be made to cause the minimum of inconvenience to site traffic or public.

The material shall be sheeted to minimise heat loss.

The transfer of material from the heap to the work area shall be by mechanical means when practically possible.

Material will be levelled by hand tools, and compacted by suitable means namely a steel drum vibratory roller or hand rammer (in inaccessible areas).

Personnel protective clothing shall be worn where there is a risk to health.

When finished the work area will be left tidy

In Summary

All necessary training shall have been given

All risks shall have been considered and best working practises adopted.

All due consideration shall have been afforded to other persons working nearby.
